



2012 Cut Bank Estate Cabernet Sauvignon

2012 was the first year of full production of the Estate Vineyard. Aromas of violet, plum, black currant and woody herbs waft out of the glass. Greeted by blackberry on the palate, the Cab opens to flavors of pomegranate, sage and crushed granite all backed by nuanced tannins. The finish is laced with black pepper and dark chocolate covered espresso beans.
