



2012 Walla Walla Valley Petit Verdot

Petit Verdot is another wine only produced in select vintages. The ripeness and balance of the 2012 vintage helped this grape step out of the shadow of its “blending varietal” moniker. As a special tribute to the stellar Frazier Bluff Vineyard, this wine represents a field blend, adding 14% Malbec to the Petit Verdot to approximate the vineyard’s acreage. Heaps of black pepper and lush tannins atop rich, dark fruit flavors of black currant and plum, backed by hints of espresso and woody herbs.
