



## 2013 Cut Bank Estate Cabernet Sauvignon

Full of bright red fruit, cherry and raspberry, from the outset. Moves through darker fruit, currant and cassis, to black cherry and just a bit of blackberry. Hints of woody herbs and undergrowth waft along the edges. Aromas of leather and tobacco are just starting to make their appearance. Grippy tannin and bracing acidity show off blackberry and blueberry flavors. Cedar, cinnamon and oak spice linger on the finish.

<b>Aging</b>	58% new French oak, 11% once-filled French oak and 31% neutral oak barrels.
<b>Fermentation</b>	Open top stainless steel tank, the cap was punched down four times a day with select pump-overs
