



2015 Red Mountain Carménère

Aromas of blackberry, red currant, and tart cherry pour out of the glass, backed by hints of black pepper, forest floor and smoky, roasted game. Lush, fine-grained tannins coat the palate and the ample acidity hints at the stellar aging potential. The lengthy finish layers toasty oak, licorice, and spice.
