



2015 Walla Walla Valley Cabernet Sauvignon

Dark and vibrant color. Raspberry, cherry and currant aromas with a floral, violet note and hints of cola and mint. A fruit-forward palate loaded with more cherry and pomegranate, underscored with orange zest, espresso and cedar. Balanced acidity and integrated tannins extend the finish through layers of black pepper, sweet oak spice, woody herbs and a touch of smoke.
