



2015 Walla Walla Valley Malbec

Dark and inky hue, hinting at purple, with dark fruit aromas to match; black raspberry, black currant and plum. Layers of black pepper, offset by hints of rosemary and mint, violet and fresh game. Thick and viscous on the palate, it gets darker still, with blackberry and blueberry pie, and loaded with more pepper. The mid-palette flavors turn to red fruit, raspberry and cherry, and a lingering finish, touched with a dash of cedar and woody herbs.
