



2016 Columbia Valley Cuvee

Red fruit aromas burst out of the glass; vibrant black cherry backed by raspberry and just a hit of strawberry. The Cuvee reveals under petal, cassis and herbed olives as it opens. The palate is packed with more black cherry, strawberry and blueberry crumble leading to cedar, black raspberry, cassis, cut hay, vanilla and integrated tannins.

Acid	6.3 g/L

Aging	Barrel aged 19 months in 45% new oak, (33% French, 6% Hungarian, 6% American) 24% once-filled French oak and 31% neutral oak barrels.
Fermentation	Open top stainless steel tank, the cap was punched down four times a day with select pump-overs
Alcohol	14.3%
